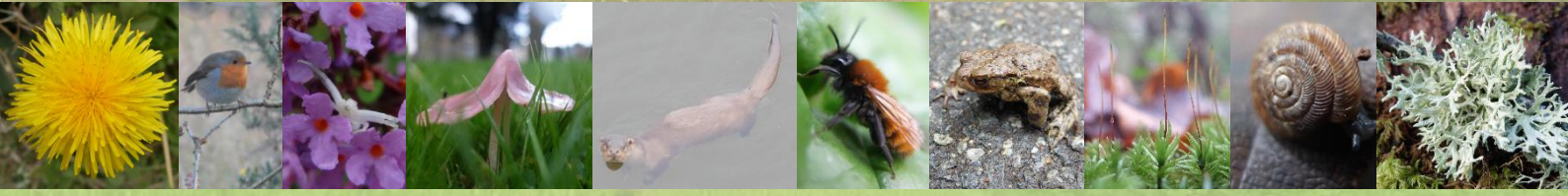


WEST WALES WILD WATCH
